As founder of the highly-charged Notism genre of abstract art, Ron Burkhardt's bi-coastal career has been marked by unconventional breakthroughs.

He has had fifty exhibitions, including Biennales in Italy, Austria and New York, Art Basel/Miami, and one man shows at prestigious galleries in Manhattan, Palm Beach, Los Angeles, Laguna Beach, Chicago, Southampton, Sao Paolo and Miami. While being featured on major television networks and winning over 200 creative awards, including the American Art Awards and a Medici Medal, he auctioned work at Sothebys and Phillips de Pury/NY, and was acquired by numerous museums, universities and discerning collectors.

Now, his organic new Earth Art genre fuses otherworldly shapes with nature's gritty color forms.
